What to do in a traffic crash

To help reduce danger to road users and minimise traffic congestion, from January 2015 you may no longer have to wait for police at a crash site in Queensland.



ENSURE YOU ARE IN A SAFE LOCATION AWAY FROM THE TRAFFIC - FOLLOW THIS GUIDE

Is anyone trapped or injured? YES



Are police needed to direct traffic or deal with hazards?

Do any drivers appear affected YES by alcohol or drugs?

Has anyone involved failed to exchange details?

Call Triple Zero (000).

Stop and give assistance to anyone who is injured if it is safe to do so.

Call Policelink 131 444.

Police do not need to attend the crash site

Does your vehicle require towing?



- 1. Contact your insurer or a towing company of your choice to arrange for your vehicle to be towed (if required). If you cannot arrange a tow
- and exhaust all other options call Policelink 131 444.
- 2. Exchange details and leave the crash site.
- 3. After leaving the crash site report the crash within 24 hours.
- 4. Report your crash to Policelink ← either online, via the smart phone app, or calling 131 444. You will be provided with a report number to assist with any
